

Tickets for Freiburg's public transport

Freiburg has zones with different prices ([Tarifzonen](#)), but the University of Education, the Bürgerhaus, the city centre as well as all hotels marked on the map, are within zone A. Unless you're planning excursions out of the city, you'll need tickets for 1 zone.

For the tickets, these are your options:

- **Single tickets** (Einzelfahrschein): 2.30€ per way
- **WelcomeKarte** (3 Tage-KombiTicket): 25€ for three days (8.3€ per day), if you're planning to see the Schauinsland (the cable car ticket is included in the price) or make excursions out of the city centre, all zones are included.

2x4 tickets (2x4-Fahrtenkarte): 16.10€ for 8 single tickets (2.01€ per ticket). The ticket can be used by several people at once. Attention: It needs to be validated every time used - one stamp for every trip and person (for the tram/bus at the machine inside, for the train at the machines at the platform)

- **24-hour ticket for one person** (Regio24): 6€, pays off if you're planning to make more than 2 trips a day.
- **24-hour ticket for five persons** (Regio24): 12€ (2.4€ if shared by five people), if you're planning to make your trips in a group of two or more.

All tickets can be purchased at the red VAG ticket machines, at the main train station and mostly also in the trams and busses. In trams, single tickets, 2x4 tickets and Regio24 tickets are sold. In busses, single tickets and Regio24 tickets are sold.
